The Montessori Regional Charter School (MRCS) will:

4. Provide parents reasonable access to staff. Specifically, staff will be available for consultation with parents by appointments as needed, as well as by telephone and email.
5. Provide parents opportunities to volunteer at Special Events throughout the school year as well as encourage parents to participate in the Parent-Teacher Organization (PTO).
