2023-2024 Enrollment Lottery Information

Thank you for considering Montessori Regional Charter School (MRCS) for your child's education.

MRCS is a **Kindergarten through Grade 8** public, tuition-free charter school offering a Montessori based education to children in the Erie region.

The information on these pages will help you prepare to enter your child into our annual enrollment lottery and understand what to expect before and after the lottery takes place:

As a public charter school we are required to have an annual lottery.

HOW IS THE LOTTERY RUN?

Picking the numbers: Lottery numbers are run through a computerized random generator.

Kindergarten Lottery: Current students' younger siblings entering Kindergarten have preference for openings. After siblings of current students are placed, we will accept Kindergartners into remaining openings in kindergarten classes according to lottery results by campus. If more students apply than the number of available openings, then a lottery will be run and students not chosen will be placed on a waiting list in order of lottery results.

Grade 1-7 Lotteries: If there are openings in grades 1-8 those are filled by siblings of students currently attending MRCS. We are usually not aware of openings that may occur after the lottery until the summer, when a child moves away or decides to go to another school. For this reason, <u>all</u> students in grades 1 through 8 are placed on a waiting list according to lottery results and campus preference.

The Lottery Process

If a charter school receives more applications than spots available in a certain grade, a lottery is held to determine who is accepted and who is placed on a waiting list. Lotteries randomly select students for enrollment, with the following possible exceptions list below:

- 1. Children of founding families of the Charter
- 2. Siblings of children enrolled at the school
- 3. Children residing in the Erie and Millcreek School Districts (chartering districts)
- 4. All other children residing in Pennsylvania

HOW DO I FIND OUT THE RESULTS OF THE LOTTERY?

The results of the lottery will be posted on the <u>school website</u> within 24 hours following the lottery. In addition, you will receive results via email <u>the following week</u>. NO RESULTS ARE GIVEN OVER THE PHONE.

HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE FOR MY CHILD TO BE CALLED IF S/HE IS ON THE WAITING LIST?

We are not aware of openings until a parent notifies us that they are moving or have decided to send their child to another school. If your child is on the waiting list, *please be patient*.

Once we contact you, you will have **24 hours to accept or decline** the offer of enrollment before we move to the next person on the waiting list.

- Be sure your writing is legible: MRCS is not responsible for an incorrect phone number or email address provided on a form due to writing that cannot be deciphered.
- Keep your contact phone number and email up to date with the enrollment office at all times
- Be sure your contact phone you provided is set up to receive calls
- Check your email

IF ONE OF MY CHILDREN IS OFFERED ENROLLMENT, WILL MY OTHER CHILDREN ALSO GET IN?

No. Siblings of an accepted student may be contacted at a later time according to their place on the waiting list if an opening occurs in their grade level. They will receive sibling preference for enrollment into available openings the following year.

DOES THE WAITING LIST CARRY OVER FROM YEAR TO YEAR?

No. Students who do not enroll for the 2023-2024 school year must re submit documents to be included in the enrollment lottery for 2024-2025.

WHAT DOCUMENTS DO I NEED FOR THE ENROLLMENT LOTTERY?

Montessori Regional Charter School is a public school and the state of Pennsylvania requires the following documentation., parents must submit state-required information and documentation for each student. Submit the following three (3) documents via email attachment to <u>enrollment@mrcserie.org</u> or IN PERSON at our administrative office. PLEASE DO NOT SUBMIT A COPY OF YOUR CHILD'S SOCIAL SECURITY CARD.

1. The 2023 Pre-Enrollment Form

Beginning January 2, 2023, the form is available online on our website, <u>www.mrcserie.org/enrollment</u>, and may be picked up at our administrative offices.

2. Either a copy of your child's Birth Certificate -OR- A Current, Valid Passport

If you can't find your child's birth certificate contact the Erie Division of Vital Statistics Office located at <u>1910 West 26th Street, Erie, PA 16508</u>. Walk-ins Welcome. Office hours are 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. 814-871-4261.

3. One Copy of Proof of Residency

A copy of **<u>TWO</u>** of the following documents.

- <u>Utility Bill</u>: Acceptable documents include gas, electric, water, or sewer bill that is dated within 60 days that includes your name and service address.
- o Mortgage Statement: dated within 60 days
- <u>Current Lease</u>: must be signed and dated by you and your landlord and must include your name and address and landlord contact information.
- Property Tax Bill: dated within 60 days
- <u>Pennsylvania Department of Transportation</u>: Driver's License –OR- Vehicle Registration card OR- Picture Identification Card showing your name and current address.

Frequently Asked Questions

IS THERE A RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT?

All students who reside in Pennsylvania are eligible for admission. If you do not live in Pennsylvania but are moving here in the near future, you will be eligible once you establish residency.

CAN MY CHILD TAKE A BUS TO SCHOOL? Some restrictions apply for <u>City of Erie Residents</u>, please read * below. The law requires your home school district to provide transportation to MRCS on the dates that MRCS is in session. Your local school district is responsible for all aspects of its pupil transportation program including routes, stops, schedules, and discipline. Your address cannot be more than 10 miles from MRCS. **The Erie City School District* will not provide bus transportation to a student who resides within 1.5 miles of the campus.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST TO ATTEND MRCS?

Montessori Regional Charter school is a free public charter school. There are no tuition fees.

DO YOU HAVE A PRESCHOOL PROGRAM?

At this time, we do not have a preschool program. However, we hope you will consider our school when your child is eligible for Kindergarten.

CAN I APPLY TO THE LOTTERY NOW?

The pre-enrollment forms for application to the enrollment lottery will be available on January 2, 2023.

WHAT IS THE DEADLINE TO GET INTO THE LOTTERY?

Your child's pre-enrollment documents must be submitted to the administrative office by 4:00 p.m. Thursday, March 23, 2023.

WHAT IF MISS THE DEADLINE?

Parents who submit their child's pre-enrollment documents after the deadline will have their child's name added to the end of waiting list after the lottery has taken place behind lottery wait-list students in order of the date and time the form is received in the office.

HOW OLD DOES MY CHILD HAVE TO BE TO ENROLL IN KINDERGARTEN?

Students interested in enrolling in MRCS Kindergarten must meet the age requirement of their resident school district. If you're not sure what the age requirement is, contact the district directly. *MRCS does not test for early admission of Kindergartners*.

I WANT MY CHILD TO REPEAT A GRADE, WHAT DO I DO?

In order to pre-enroll for your child's current grade level, a certified Letter of Retention from your child's school principal must be submitted with the pre-enrollment application.
