


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As we begin the new school year during the COVID-19 pandemic, things are going to look different!

Making the Decision for Remote Learning

Over the past several months, MRCS has been preparing for the new school year at a time when each day brings new information about the virus, its transmission, how it affects different age groups and how to mitigate spreading the disease. **Our number one priority is to protect the health, safety and wellbeing of our students, teachers, other school staff, their families, and our communities.** While we all want our students to return as soon as possible, we want to make sure that returning is safe for everyone.

In deciding how to open school this year, we have consulted with and followed the guidance and directives of:

- Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)
- Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE)
- State Department of Health (DOH)
- · State of Pennsylvania Governor's office
- Erie County Department of Health (DOH)
- County and Municipal Health Department (CMHD)
- Our chartering districts Erie School District and Millcreek School District

Making the Decision for Remote Learning

Most importantly, we monitor the <u>Department of Health Covid-19 Data for Pennsylvania</u> daily to determine the spread of the virus in our own community. As you have probably seen in the news, the cases in Erie County have continued to rise over the past several weeks. As we write this, the incident rate stands at 5.9% which indicates community spread. While it is difficult to predict what will happen in the next few weeks, we have watched as other states and communities have opened schools under similar conditions, only to shut them down as students and staff infection rates rise.

Therefore, MRCS has decided that the best decision for our students, staff, families and community is to follow Erie School District's lead and open the school on

TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 8, 2020 WITH TOTAL REMOTE LEARNING.

The Reopening Plan

In this reopening plan, you will find information about the new school year and how it will differ from the online schooling that MRCS offered this past spring.

- Remote instruction will follow the school day schedule.
- Classes will be livestreamed, allowing students to participate in lessons and interact with their peers and teachers in real time.
- Lessons will also be available in an MRCS online video library so families can access the lessons outside the traditional school day.
- We will also make sure that you have all of the tools, materials and supplies you need at your own home with new dedicated Chromebooks for each student, a supply box and Montessori materials.
- And, you will have the support, both technical and academic, to assist your student in your at-home Montessori classroom.

What to Expect During Remote Instruction

Students will be engaged in daily online classes with their classroom teacher. Teachers will present live lessons and instruction throughout the school day, while some lessons presented may be pre-recorded by the teacher. Students will have the opportunity to interact with their peers by asking questions and regularly participating in community meetings.

What to Expect

- Students will follow a regular school day schedule to ensure that they meet
 Pennsylvania's requirements for 180 days of instruction
- Live and recorded Montessori lessons presented to students
- Lesson materials and follow up work will be provided to all students
- Lessons that are aligned with Pennsylvania's Academic Standards will be delivered – teachers will follow our scope and sequence
- Students will be provided with a MRCS issued Chromebook and Supplies/Materials
- Supplemental materials, assignments, and class announcements will be available through Google Classroom
- Ability to pick up copies of materials and drop off completed assignments

Conducting on line family/teacher conferences through the chromebooks and opening up teacher office hours so families can communicate their concerns and issues directly with their child's teacher

FOR FALL 2020, MRCS WILL:

Provide at home supply packets to ensure that every student has the materials they need to do their daily lessons (pencils, paper, white boards, markers, crayons, ruler, scissors etc)





Attendance

We want to make sure that every student has some online face to face communication with their teacher on a regular basis. **This means many students will be online with their class every day beginning at 8:30 am.**Teachers will take "attendance" through visually seeing the student on screen each day.

In addition, attendance will be noted by the submission of required assignments based on the lessons of the week. Since some students will not be "on screen" all day (based on a families' work schedule) the submission of required work will be critical in determining if student's are participating daily/weekly and most importantly, assessing their understanding of the curriculum.

Families of students who are unable to attend (be online) for all or most of the day, every day, will be asked to complete a support form and a customized schedule will be developed.
