When the school will be utilizing a Remote Instruction Day, families will be notified through the ParentSquare Portal. If you have not done so already, please be sure you are set up to receive emails and text messages from this application.

Before Thanksgiving break, we will be sending home two days of learning packets with each student. These should be kept at home in a safe, easy-to-find place. We will not collect the packets unless we utilize a Remote Instruction Day.

If MRCS announces a Remote Instruction Day, you will also receive a digital copy of the packet from your child's teacher, along with support throughout the day via ParentSquare or email. Please have your child complete only the assignments their teacher provides for that day.
