School Wide Title I

"raising academic achievement for ALL students..."

What is Title I?

- Federally funded program to help children who struggle in the areas of reading and math
- Extra help in the areas of reading and math
- This extra help is in addition to what they are learning in the classroom.
- ♦ Types of Programs:
 - ♦ School-wide all students
 - ♦ Targeted students identified for the program based on performance on assessments.
 - ♦ MRCS has a school-wide program.

Our Title I Program:

- Smaller groups or one to one instruction
- Additional teachers.
- Extra time for teaching, re-teaching, and practicing Reading and Math skills.
- A variety of supplementary teaching methods
- An individualized program for students.
- Additional teaching materials which supplement their regular instruction.

Eligibility for Title I Services

How do students qualify?

Benchmark/Assessments

- MRCS students are benchmarked three times per year utilizing a variety of assessments:
 - ♦ Acadience
 - ♦ NWEA MAP
 - ♦ Classroom Diagnostic Tools
 - ♦ Classroom Assessments
 - **♦** PSSA
- Assessments are used to help teachers determine if a student is understanding the content presented in the classroom.
- Our goal (and the State's goal) is for your student to be successful in reading and math and to reach the "Proficient" level on the PSSA.

Proficiency Levels

• If a child does not reach a certain proficiency level when they take an assessment, we consider them for additional help from our Title I program.

Parent's Rights

- **♦** Teacher Qualifications
- Non-Highly Qualified Teacher for four or more weeks
- Request opportunities to meet regularly with staff for parent involvement
- Participate in decisions affecting your child
- ◆ FACT (Family Advisory Council for Title I).
